New user can contact the District Administration for Registration of their mobile or Contact District Informatics Officer /Assosiate Kanyakumari District.

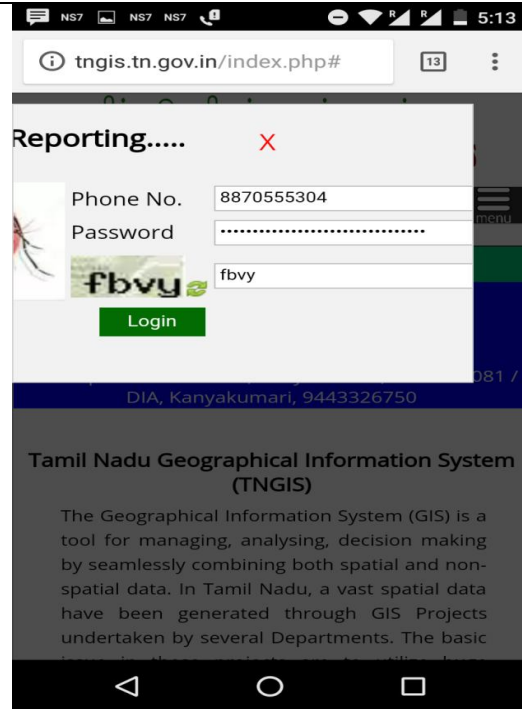
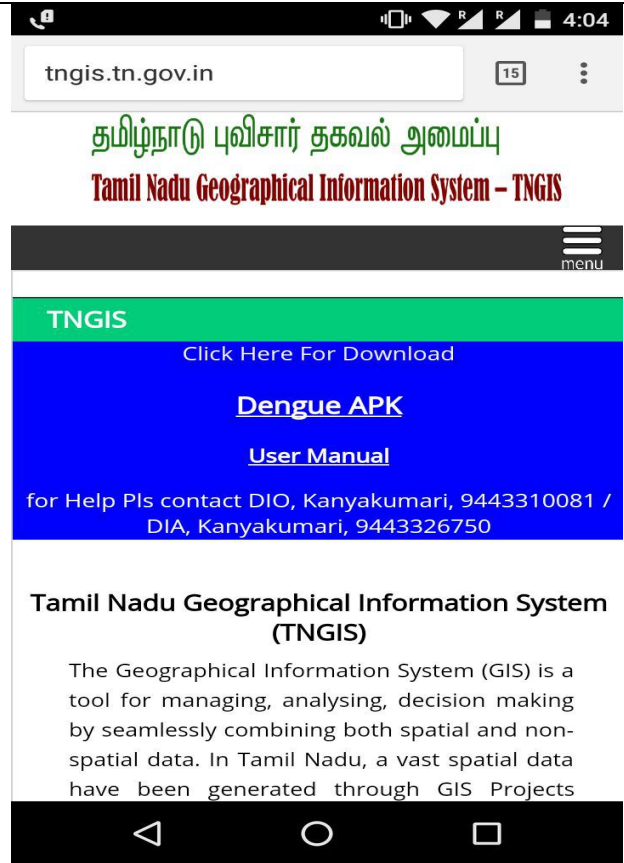
For Registered Doctor/Institution

Enter the Captcha String

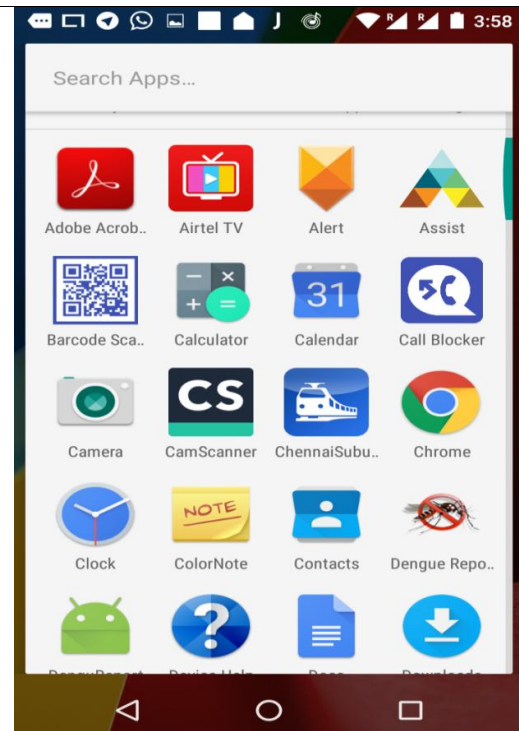
Click on the Login Button.

Step 3: Download Dengue mobile application and install the application on your mobile.



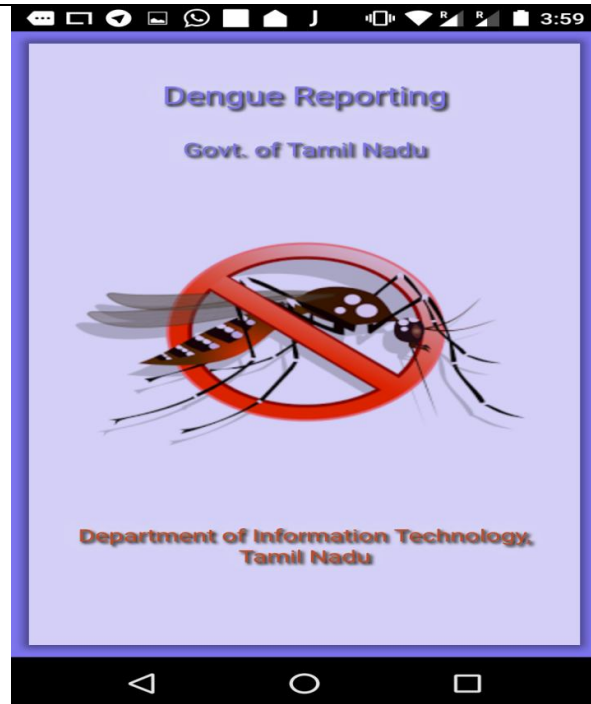
Step 4: Open "Dengue Reporting" Mobile app

Dengue incidence reporting shall be carried out by the list of Doctors shared by the District Administration. Use the mobile number in which the initial SMS was sent.

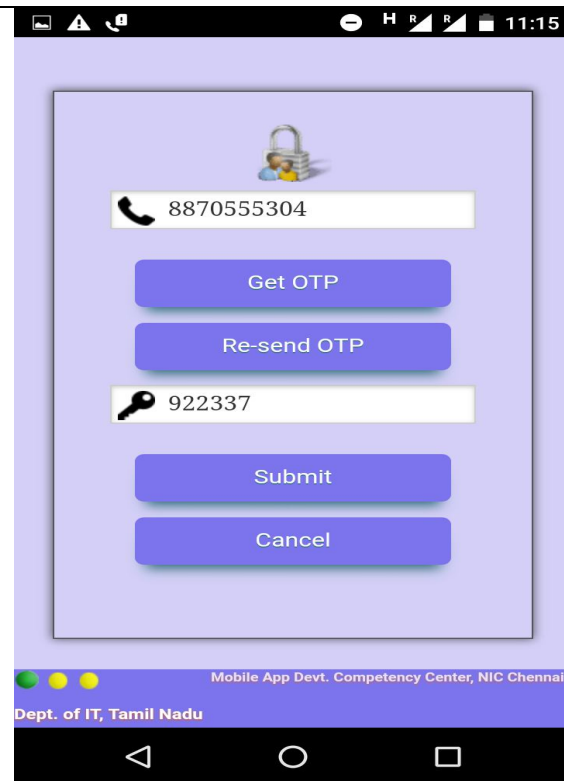
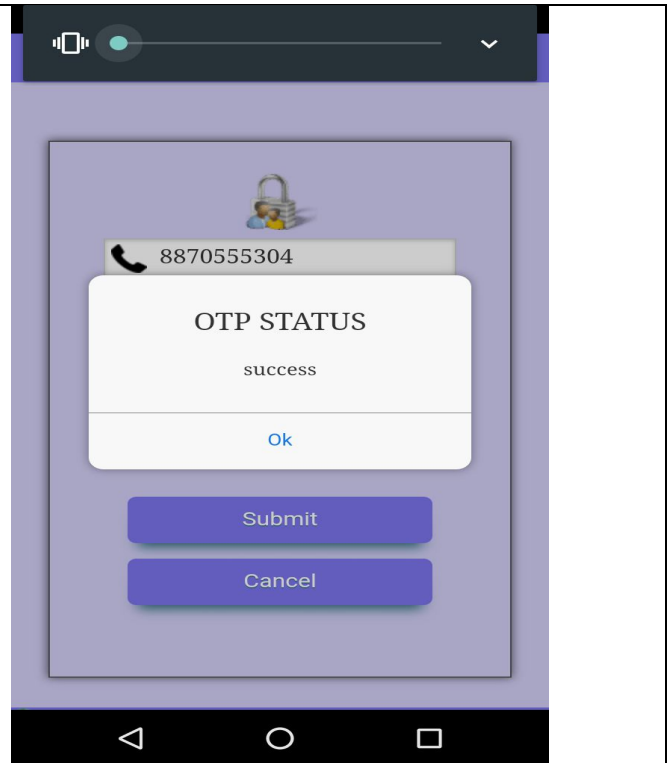
Enter you valid mobile no

You will get the OTP Status message



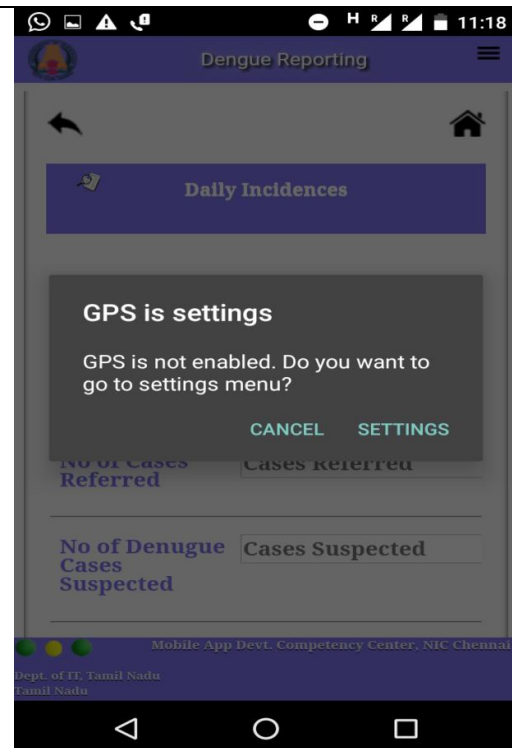
Once you received the OTP, Enter the OTP and Click on the Submit Button.

Click on Settings and Switch on GPS

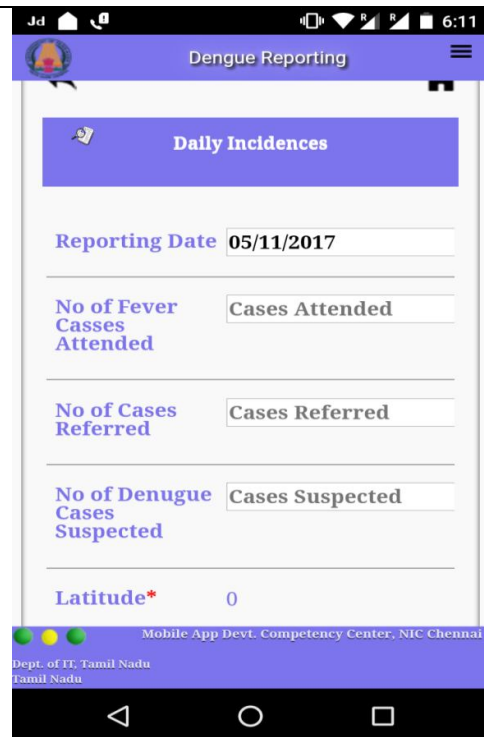
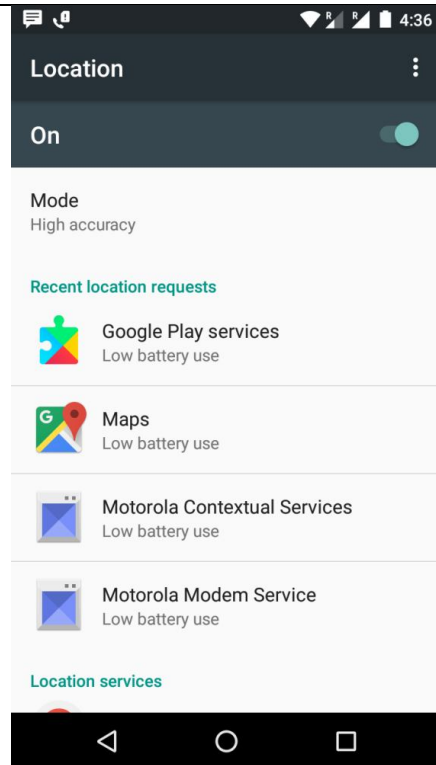

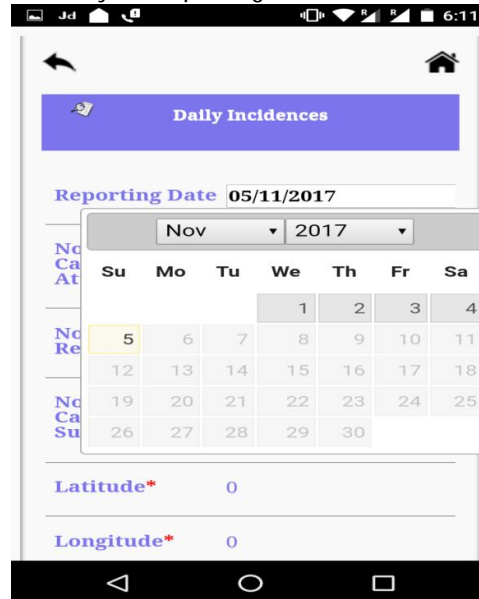
GPS settings is shown as "Location"

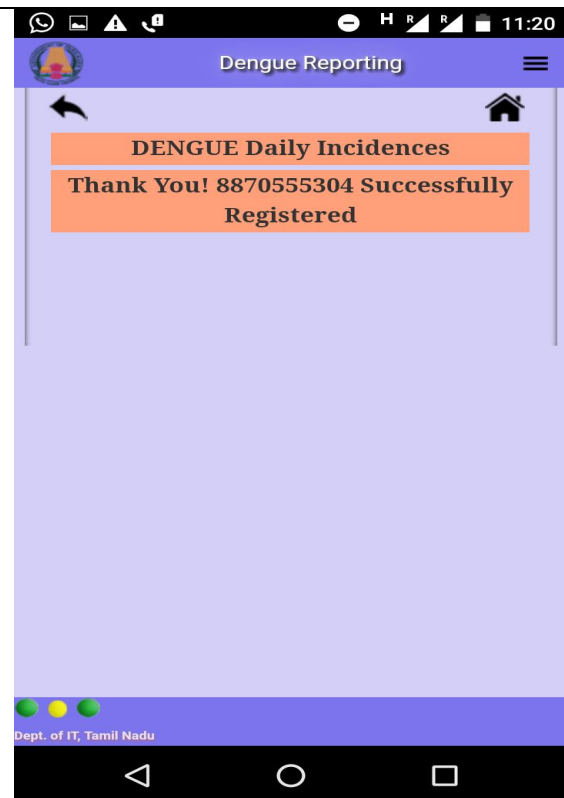
